RUBY PARK was in hand in the early going, closed the gap in the turn, assumed command in the drive and drew clear under a hand ride. ERINSVILLE was unhurried early along the rail, saved ground throughout, found her best stride in the final furlong and got up for place. KY. PRINCESS showed good early speed and was unchallenged on the lead, faltered at the 1/4 pole and weakened late just losing place. GOLDEN PATH moved to the rail in the early going and was allowed to settle but lacked a late response. COOL CHINOOK was void of early speed in the four path and never a factor. EXPLOSIVE LYNN broke sharply but had a mild stumble at the start then dueled briefly in the backstretch but dropped back quickly. SING 'N' DANCE showed little and was outrun.
