SUSUR, well back early, closed four-wide late turn, lapped on the leader a furlong out then outfinished KERRY FAIR under a drive. KERRY FAIR dueled on the backstretch, shook clear early turn and set the pace, was under pressure in the final furlong and gave way grudgingly in the late stages. ALIADO, well back early, moved off the rail late turn then rallied between foes. SHOWSTOPPER raced midpack, was hustled between horses late turn, was all out in the stretch but hung late. KYOQUOT SOUND stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn but did not threaten. COTTAGE LINK dueled to the turn, was headed but gave chase then tired at the top of the stretch. FULL IMPULSE, off slowly, trailed along the rail and never reached contention. DANCING LEAVES stalked the pace, chased briefly on the turn then faded along the rail.
