EAGLE POISE, rated off the pace, came five-wide through the far turn, was pushed out a bit at the top of the stretch, finished all out and just got up. RED LEADER showed brief speed and settled, stalked the pace, chased into the stretch and ducked out a bit, challenged the pacesetter, dueled to the end and had a narrow advantage in deep stretch but missed to the outside charger. LITTLE RED CHRIS led on the first turn, set a reserved pace, was collared at the top of the stretch, dueled gamely but missed. DR. FUNKENSTEIN, off a step slowly, raced midpack, closed angling out six-wide late turn then evened out late. COPOLA raced off the pace in hand between foes, was hustled through the far turn angling from the third path to the seventh path, chased into the stretch and finished evenly. NAVAL STRIKE, in touch, chased on the far turn, was in striking range at the top of the stretch but flattened out. STARDUST ZIGGY, unhurried early, angled six-wide chasing on the turn but never threatened. COUNT FLOYD, rated off the pace, angled out closing late turn but evened out in the stretch. HYDRO HANDSHAKE, in touch to early on the far turn, faded four and five-deep and was through.
