(No Canadian Bred Allowance) (Note: Grades as recognized by the International Cataloguing Standards Committee) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$6,000, which includes the entry fee. (Closed with 21 Nominations) *Plus up to \$24,300 Ontario Sired/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards.

NEVER RETREAT stalked the pacesetter from the second path, bid upper stretch and drove clear then turned back MEKONG MELODY (IRE) and finished under a hand ride. BAY TO BAY raced midpack between rivals, was boxed in upper stretch, angled out midstretch and rallied gamely. MEKONG MELODY (IRE) stalked three-wide, bid midstretch but was no match and backed away. MISS KELLER (IRE) settled off the pace, angled out midstretch and bumped with a rival then finished gamely. STARS TO SHINE stalked the pace from the rail, was squeezed back at the turn, was blocked a 16th out then rallied late when clear. FOREST UPROAR, away alertly, raced three-wide in midpack, encountered traffic upper stretch, angled out and rallied. VALLI WITH A VOW, rated off the pace, came three and four-wide through the turn, rallied outside but evened out in the late stages. NO EXPLAINING (IRE) stalked along the rail, was hustled into the stretch, faced traffic upper stretch and again midstretch and flattened out. JENNY'S SO GREAT raced midpack four-wide, was bumped midstretch and evened out. WAR TIGRESS set a reserved pace, was hustled late turn then was headed upper stretch, chased briefly and tired.
