CROWN ISLE held a short early lead but was soon headed, forced the pace from the rail, was involved in a little jostling at the top of the stretch, bid midstretch and quickly drove clear then widened under steady pressure. COFFEE BAR, off a step slowly, gained contention quickly, angled out from the rail to three-wide launching a fast move to take a short lead early turn, was also involved in the jostling as the outside partner at the top of the stretch, maintained a narrow advantage until headed midstretch and chased to the end. HISAKI gained a short lead on the backstretch, was headed early turn, chased ate turn and was sandwiched at the top of the stretch, lost his path briefly a few strides later then finished gamely. AWESOME RHYTHM, rated in range, closed late turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but had no serious response. ME THE SEA AND G T stalked the pace in hand, chased four-deep into the stretch, chased briefly and evened out midstretch.
