JENNY'S SO GREAT raced off the pace in hand, closed along the rail late turn, responded smartly a furlong out and surged to the lead in the late stages. TWO WONDERS stalked the pace, bid late turn, shook clear a furlong out then failed to hold the winner safe. FLOWER EXCHANGE raced off the pace, circled into the stretch and rallied gamely. MEDAL WINNER raced off the pace, bumped with GYPSY SAGE at the top of the stretch then finished gamely. GYPSY SAGE raced off the pace, was hustled between foes late turn, bumped with MEDAL WINNER at the top of the stretch and flattened out. EXECUTIVE STAR, in range, was hustled late turn then evened out midstretch. BREWELLA, in touch, was hustled along the rail on the turn but failed to sustain her bid at the top of the stretch and tired. FRECKLED ROSE raced midpack, was hustled on the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out. PERFECT TAP led early, set the pace, was engaged late turn and tired.
