Footnotes

SIN CODIGO (ARG), taken well back early, saved ground while in hand, responded smartly, split foes midstretch and swept by the leader under a hand ride. MACALLAN, up close inside, bid upper stretch, led briefly but was headed in deep stretch. COOL KAHUNA led early, set the pace, was headed upper stretch but chased determinedly to the wire. PRIZED HUMOUR raced in midpack along the rail, chased into the stretch, was blocked along the rail then finished gamely once clear. KINGS PARADE settled off the pace, closed four-wide on the turn, chased five-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. KEEP THE CHIEF, rated in range, chased into the stretch, was up close midstretch but did not lodge a bid and evened out. SLIGOVITZ raced off the pace, closed four-wide late turn then evened out in the late stages. HOLY SCHNEIKIES pressed the pace, forced the issue on the turn, bid upper stretch but failed to sustain the drive. DUBAI ECHO, in range, chased late turn then tired in the stretch.
