CATALEENDA was sent to the early lead, was engaged and vied into the turn, shook clear late turn and widened, driving. DANCING CHARM broke alertly but was outfooted for the lead, chased on the turn and finished gamely in vain. HEART OF COLD forced the pace, chased three-wide on the turn and evened out late. RARE SOLITAIRE raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide, came five-wide into the stretch and rallied. TOMAHAWK GAP raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn, came four-wide to the top of the stretch, finished all out but did not threaten. BACK TO YOU, well back early, closed three-wide late turn and rallied mildly. PRECIOUS JADE raced midpack between foes, came three-wide to the top of the stretch but never threatened. DEER FAN raced off the pace along the rail and lacked the necessary closing response. BOB N WEAWE closed quickly to engage the leader nearing the turn, vied briefly, gave way late turn and tired.
