SECRET GETAWAY showed early foot then pressed the pace three-wide, gained command midstretch and drove clear. BARRELING HOME had early speed, gained a short lead late backstretch, vied outside MARLANG on the turn, was headed midstretch and gave way while clearly best of the rest. MARLANG broke poorly, quickly gained contention, dueled from the rail on the turn, yielded midstretch and tired. DISCREET COMMANDER, in range, was hustled along the rail on the turn, finished all out but failed to gain. DYLAN'S CHOICE rated off the pace in the early going, trailed through the turn and never reached contention. SEPTEMBER SQUARE was well back early, saved ground and was hustled through the turn but had no late response. FIND THE WIRE stalked close up from the outside then tired in the stretch.
