CAITIE MARIE stalked the pace, cut to the rail at the turn, closed, bid midstretch and drove clear late. JUICY GOSSIP raced off the pace, chased hard three to five-wide on the turn, rallied outside and gained steadily. MELLIEHA BAY forced the pace, took command late backstretch, moved clear on the turn, was all out through the stretch but failed to stay. WAITING FOR TIME settled off the pace, was hustled late backstretch but was steadied slightly behind a rival at the turn, chased to the stretch then was eased up in the final yards when blocked. VIDA'S RUCKUS held a narrow early lead, was headed late backstretch, chased on the turn then tired in the final furlong. YIKES AT LAST forced the early pace, chased on the turn then tired in the stretch. WEDDING PLANS stalked from the rail, was squeezed back at the turn, saved ground but lacked a rally.
