Footnotes

BEARAVIE forced the pace on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, chased into the stretch, bid and led quickly then held sway under a drive. DONNA'S BAD GIRL settled off the pace, circled five-wide late turn, lugged in through the stretch and bumped LEENANE'S LULLABY upper stretch then finished gamely. SECOND ACT raced off the pace, angled out upper stretch then rallied late outside. MIDNIGHT RAWKS stalked three and four-wide, chased into the stretch, was bumped as part of a chain reaction upper stretch, continued to chase then gave way late. TERESA'S PRIDE settled off the pace, saved ground then rallied belatedly between horses. LEENANE'S LULLABY, in touch three-wide, chased into the stretch and was bumped, launched an all out drive but tired late. WHITEWATER MIST settled off the pace between rivals, angled from four-wide to the rail midstretch, lacked a clear path then finished well when clear but was too late to menace. WISE DOLLY set a pressured pace, shook clear into the turn, was set down at the top of the stretch, was quickly passed and tired. CLARKSTON GINNY raced in midpack, came three-wide through the turn then tired in the stretch. ONEMOREGILLYGIRL stalked the pace, was hustled along the rail late turn then tired in the stretch.
