Footnotes

SELBORNE broke in the air and was allowed to settle just off the rail, rallied on the turn while saving ground and split horses entering the stretch, drew even with a furlong to go and prevailed under strong pressure. DIVINE CLASS stalked the early pace just off the rail, drew even three wide entering the stretch, gained a short lead in the drive, but was outfinished. MISS JOKER was allowed to settle off the rail, roused in the three path on the turn and closed the gap four wide in the drive, but flattened out in the late going. FREEDOM COME pressed the early pace from off the rail, drew even at the quarter pole, then got tired in the late going. PTARMIGAN HUNTING stalked the early pace three wide, but lacked a late response and dropped back. CORAL CLIFF set the early pace in hand along the rail, then faltered at the quarter pole and faded. DANCE ACADEMY was void of early speed outside of rivals and never rallied. CLASSICAL RUCKUS showed little and was outrun. MANZEE BLUE was bumped at the start and dropped back, then trailed and never rallied.
