Footnotes

LIVE WELL off a step slowly, remained unhurried on the rail, began to pick up horses on the second path early on the far turn, closed fast outside late turn and took command at the top of the stretch, drove clear and widened under pressure then was taken in hand nearing the wire. MRS. MISTOFEELES raced five-wide into the first turn, remained out there and closed late backstretch, bid three-wide midturn but was no match for the winner at the top of the stretch then held the place. BELLE DE NEUVILLE was well back while saving ground, circled the field late turn and finished best of the rest. WISE GIFT was under strong restraint early on the rail, bid inside SWEET BAY late backstretch, dueled through the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. ROUGE STONE raced three-wide midpack, was set down on the far turn but hung. SWEET BAY sprinted clear to set the pace, was under pressure by rivals on the backstretch, dueled into the turn and was very game under a strong ride to the top of the stretch then tired. WEST END LADY raced four-wide on the first turn, continued in the middle of the pack, moved to the rail and saved ground through the far turn but lacked a closing response. BRIGHT REAGENT stalked between rivals then faded on the far turn. PRIZE AND HONOR stalked three-wide to the far turn then tired.
