PROFESSOR'S RIDE forced the pace from the rail, bid into the turn and took a short lead, was pressured through the turn then shook clear at the top of the stretch, was given light encouragement upper stretch then finished under a hand ride. VICAR OF DIBLEY, bothered at the start, was steadied behind rivals late backstretch, closed three-wide late turn then moved to the rail a furlong out and finished gamely. SEABOA, off alertly, was quickly joined in a duel, was headed by a second rival at the turn, forced the pace to the top of the stretch then evened out late. ROCKET COLLEEN, in range, chased hard late turn but failed to menace. SUNSHINE JENNY was sent quickly to the fore, dueled, was headed at the turn, forced the issue but evened out in the stretch. SHIMMER OF GOLD was hustled along from off the pace, saved ground but never reached contention. MANATEE DIVERS broke outward, raced up close along the inside, chased along the rail through the turn then evened out in the stretch. BOLD CAILIN raced off the pace, came three-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. BANK ON IT, in range, chased four-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
