DIVINE DESTINY raced off the pace, was hustled late turn, angled out upper stretch, responded to encouragement and got up late, driving. DIVA DAWN raced off the pace, closed four-wide late turn, was all out and bid in deep stretch but was outkicked. SOUTHERN FLAME dueled, was headed late backstretch, rebid late turn, shook clear upper stretch but was engaged and yielded in deep stretch. PYOTE, off the early pace, was in touch late turn, showed a mild close but did not threaten. BACK TO THERAPY dueled early and gained a short lead into the turn, was engaged late turn, vied into the stretch and yielded, chased briefly and tired. KASABLANCA EXPRESS, in range early, was roused along the rail late turn, angled out upper stretch but evened out late. MY NATALIE stalked the duel, chased on the turn then flattened out in the final furlong.
