COSTALIVIN raced off the early pace, closed along the rail early turn, was patient behind rivals late turn then launched his rally at the top of the stretch but was blocked a furlong out, altered course to the inside, responded smartly and got up late under steady pressure. GYPSY RING raced off the pace, closed six-wide into the stretch, gained steadily to the end and just missed. DANIEL BE GOOD set a reserved pace, was collared by PASO DOBLE a furlong out, held off that one but yielded to the winner in the late stages. PASO DOBLE stalked the pace, was hustled between foes into the stretch, bid a furlong out, was determined to the end but hung. CHILKOOT PASS raced midpack, was boxed in late turn then lacked a stretch response when clear. PRIVATE MEETING, in touch, was hustled four-wide on the turn but never threatened. THE BOY'S RING stalked the pace, was well positioned four-wide at the top of the stretch but came up empty when asked. FIRETHEEXECUTIVE, in touch, raced four and five-wide on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but had no response.
