INDIAN POND raced off the pace, angled from three to six-wide late turn, rallied outside and was just up, driving. MO JO QUEEN stalked the pace, was hustled five-wide into the stretch, rallied determinedly, bid in deep stretch, led for a jump but missed. ATHENA ROSE stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn, launched an all out drive, bid late and missed. D'WILD SONG had early speed, was clear on the turn, held to the late stages and tired. GALLIMARD raced midpack, chased four-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. RETA ELEANORA forced the pace two-wide, chased late turn then evened out along the rail. SMART BRASS, well back early two and three-wide, angled six-wide late turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. IMPROVISING, rated early, was hustled along the rail late turn but flattened out midstretch. PHOENIX COURT, off slowly, trailed throughout.
