UNCATCHABLE FIRE raced off the pace, closed four-wide late turn, rallied outside, bid a 16th out and prevailed driving. THE BULL GOT SHOT, in midpack early, chased into the stretch, took the lead a furlong out but failed to hold the winner safe in the late stages. DR. HARKNESS raced in midpack, chased four-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. CANT CATCH WYNSTON raced off the pace, came three-wide through the turn then rallied late between foes. PARK PLACE settled off the pace, circled late turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch then rallied belatedly. TRAJECTAMAX raced in midpack along the rail, was blocked midstretch, moved out between horses and tendered a late run. MIST OPPORTUNITY, always in touch, forced the pace late turn, took command upper stretch, was headed midstretch and tired. NOT SO GRIEM settled in range, chased along the rail late turn then evened out in deep stretch. BURLEIGH edged clear late backstretch, set a pressured pace, was caught upper stretch and tired.
