**Footnotes**

WEATHER BILL, prominent from the outset, dueled on the turn, shook clear into the stretch, widened when urged then was taken in hand. MATTANGEL raced in midpack, chased five-wide late turn and rallied gamely. LIP SINGER dueled, was headed at the turn, chased to the stretch then finished determinedly. MIA'S MYSTIC bid into the turn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased briefly then evened out. GRANDMA'S PASSION, off slowly, raced in midpack, was hustled late turn then finished gamely but was not a threat. VINTAGE STORM settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn then tendered a mild rally outside. TOP ROD raced in midpack, chased four-wide on the turn but showed no serious response in the stretch. OENOMAUS, in range early, dropped back on the turn and evened out in the stretch. BEAU WHO settled off the pace, closed late turn then evened out in the stretch. FAMOUS RELATIONS settled off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. T D BOB, off slowly, raced in midpack but faded late backstretch under a ride and had no rally. ATLANTIC AIR dueled, was headed at the turn, dropped back and lacked a late response.
