LISBONVALE, close early, dropped back a bit on the turn, launched her rally five-wide leaving the turn, bid a furlong out and got up late. WISE TIMMY, always in touch, closed three-deep late turn, bid at the top of the stretch but was outfinished. PRINCESSJADYNATTO, well back early, was roused to get her going on the backstretch, closed fast five-wide late turn and was gaining late. FOXS CONSORT stalked the pace, bid four-wide late turn, led to deep stretch and tired. IN A MINUTE raced midpack, closed between horses late turn, was checked inside NO KISSING upper stretch then hung. CHAMPS FINALE broke alertly, dropped well off the pace, closed late turn along the second path but never reached contention. TINAKILLY, well back early, closed

between foes on the turn then flattened out. REGENT LIGHT saved ground while off the pace, moved three-deep late turn and did not threaten. TEE CUBED was hustled along four-wide while off the pace then lacked a rally. NO KISSING dueled, shook clear briefly midturn then tired at the top of the stretch. DEVILISHLY BOLD, well back early, raced between foes and faded late turn. JB'S IRISH LASS stalked the pace, faded along the rail late turn. ALWAYS GREAT raced midpack then faded four-wide late turn. DANCE WITH HAILEY dueled along the rail, was headed midturn, chased briefly and tired.
