### Footnotes

STELLA BLUE (FR) led early, set a pressured pace, was engaged late turn and upper stretch but held gamely to the end. VIRGINIA PLAIN trailed, rallied between foes leaving the turn, angled out in the stretch and finished determinedly. COTOPAXI closed four-wide late turn, bid upper stretch but failed to sustain her drive. SAVING GROUND stalked close up, bid three-deep late turn, failed to match strides and evened out in the late stages. TRAIN TO GLORY raced midpack between foes, was all out in the stretch. EXTRA BASES showed brief speed, settled and stalked three-wide then evened out in the stretch. GOOD AS GOLD broke in the air, raced off the pace three-wide, swung out at the top of the stretch but did not threaten. FOAMY WATER stalked from the rail, moved up inside the leader on the turn to force the issue, bid at the top of the stretch but tired. BETWEEN THE CLOUDS saved ground while racing midpack, was roused at the top of the stretch but showed no response. QUESTUARY was well back early, saved ground, lacked a rally.
