CLEMENT ROCK stalked the pace, chased three-wide into the stretch, bid three-sixteenths out and swept clear then held under a drive. CELTIC CONVICTON stalked the pace, moved inside the leader to force the pace, checked in tight at the turn, rebid inside the leader and dueled in earnest late turn, was passed upper stretch but finished determinedly. RIVER LEMON raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn then finished gamely between foes. COZY KITTEN, rated in range, chased from the rail late turn then finished determinedly between horses. THUNDERING WATERS raced off the pace along the rail, angled out late turn and launched an all out drive from the outside. ALPHA BETTOR raced in midpack along the rail, chased through the stretch but failed to menace. SILVERLEO, steadied at the outset, raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn but never reached contention. JOES BLAZING AARON showed early speed, set a pressured pace, dueled late turn, was headed upper stretch and tired.
