Footnotes

GREATTOBELOVED came through to set a pressured pace inside of MOLINARO MELODY, drew off in the stretch. POWER GEM stalked the forced pace from the inside, finished well three wide to get up for the place position late. MELTING POINT stalked the forced pace three wide, made a bid on the turn, and was outfinished for the place position. TOUR D'STAR raced five wide, gained late. LA PETITE JUSTICE broke through the gate a split second before the start, broke in the air, trailed early, advanced off the rail to stalk the forced pace on the turn, and was not a threat. ARROGANCE raced three wide, and passed tired ones. MISS RACHEL MARIE was four wide, advanced mildly on the turn, dropped back in the stretch. MOLINARO MELODY had a short lead early, pressed the pace outside of the winner, gave way on the turn, and faded. A Stewards' inquiry following the race determined that LA PETITE JUSTICE did not receive a fair start and was declared a non-starter.
