Footnotes

PEAKABOO PEAK raced prominently from the outside, took command early on the turn and drew clear then held sway under a drive. IT'S ABOUT SILVER well back early on the rail, moved four-wide midturn then rallied late between horses. A TWIST OF SHERREE stalked from the third path, was roused at the top of the stretch and finished gamely under steady encouragement. TOUR D'STAR dueled early then yielded to DANCE LESSONS, remained in touch then closed late turn but hung in the late stages. JULES RULES well back early, moved off the rail late turn and rallied belatedly. TEMPT HER was hustled along the third path but failed to threaten. DANCE LESSONS up close early on the rail, took command on the backstretch, led into the turn then was no match for PEAKABOO PEAK, chased to the stretch and tired. RECHE DIAMANT stalked from the rail then faded leaving the turn.
