Footnotes

TETHRA'S WORD chased from outside rivals on the backstretch, was hustled three and four-wide through the turn, swept to the lead in the final furlong and widened under a drive. ROWANBERRY ROAD was used early, led into the turn, was hustled along but failed to stave off the winner in the final furlong. ARTICULATING raced off the pace, was hustled angling from three to five-wide on the turn then chased through the stretch. SPANISH NATIVE, well back early, angled from the second path to four-wide on the turn then closed willingly, but late. MADAME TOUMANOVA chased from between rivals on the turn, came three-wide into the stretch then evened out late. WEEKENDONTHEBEACH pressed the pace from the rail on the backstretch, chased on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. DEVIL'S BLAST was hustled from off the pace and never reached contention. LORI'S BUNNY raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn but lacked a stretch response.
