D'ORO DIABLO led early, dueled from the rail on the turn, wore down CROSS EVERY BRIDGE late turn but was joined by GYPSY RING approaching the stretch, battled gamely and prevailed under a drive. GYPSY RING raced off the pace, angled from two to four-wide closing on the turn, bid late turn, dueled through the stretch but hung. KID CANUCK, in touch, angled three to six-wide on the turn, was all out through the stretch but did not tender a bid. CAFE ELEKTRIK (GB) raced off the pace, closed between rivals on the turn, chased four-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. BEAR'S FUTURE settled off the pace, was hustled along the rail through the turn, angled out nearing the stretch but failed to threaten. WELCHTOWN raced off the pace four-wide, chased five-wide into the stretch then flattened out. DANIEL BE GOOD pressed the pace from the rail, edged up inside the leader late backstretch but was taken back from tight quarters at the turn, stalked to the stretch and tired. CROSS EVERY BRIDGE stalked the pace, challenged early turn, dueled while drifting out a bit, gave way late turn and tired.
