Footnotes

PHIL'S THUNDER showed speed, shook clear mid backstretch, set the pace then held sway, driving. TYPICAL DAYDREAM, off a step slowly, settled in midpack, was hustled on the turn then rallied gamely in vain. SEANAIEH raced in midpack, closed two-wide late turn then finished gamely along the rail. FILL YOUR BOOTS raced in midpack, chased six-wide late turn and rallied mildly. SLEW OF ENVY, in range, was hustled late turn but evened out in deep stretch. JUST ONE SURVIVOR stalked the pace, chased late turn then flattened out midstretch. STORMY RAINBOW led briefly, was headed and stalked the new pacesetter, chased late turn but flattened out in the stretch. RESAMA raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention.

ARTIC TUNDRA settled off the pace, was hustled into the stretch but failed to reach contention. FOREVER BEST raced in midpack early, settled off the pace, chased from the rail late turn then evened out in the stretch. CHARISMATIC CHARM, always well off the pace and off the rail, lacked a rally. KNIGHTMASTER, away slowly, settled well off the pace and lacked a rally. SUNDERLAND, rated off the pace, closed between foes on the turn, bobbed just inside the furlong marker and was being pulled up, just crossed the wire before stopping and was vanned off.
