### Footnotes

HIGHLAND MOOD was in hand reserved off the early lead, drew even on the turn and assumed command in upper stretch, opened a clear lead in the drive and prevailed under steady pressure. MOONLIGHT AFFAIR was off a step slowly, then hustled along between horses, closed the gap in upper stretch and was a clear second at the wire. MARJORIE DAW was allowed to settle outside of rivals, raced between horses on the turn and finished evenly. ROYAL ASCOT was close up between horses and lacked a late response in an even effort. FOOL'S JADE was allowed to settle inside of rivals and was never a threat. CRUMPET broke sharply and set the early pace unchallenged, then faltered entering the stretch and faded in the drive.
