PALACE OF DREAMS broke sharply and set the early pace in hand, had a slight challenge entering the stretch, but responded to left handed urging in the drive and held sway under steady pressure. REDCARPETTREATMENT stalked the early pace outside of rivals, roused three wide on the turn and made a mild bid, but flattened out slightly in the drive and just lasted for place. QUEEN OF THE BLUES was allowed to settle in the middle of the pack, rallied along the rail and finished evenly. DUBLIN LINE was in hand inside of rivals, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. WHEAT QUEEN was off slowly and void of early speed, never rallied and was never a factor. AWESOME DEED was void of early speed and outrun.
