RUNNAWAY MY WAY stalked the pace, was roused late turn, bid along the rail in the final furlong, drove clear midstretch then held under steady handling. COOK'S LOOK, close early, angled from three to five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch, finished all out and just missed. GAS N DASH vied on the backstretch, was headed near the turn, failed with a bid midturn, continued to press and rebid at the top of the stretch, dueled, was passed a sixteenth out, bested the early leader but had to settle for third. SEA LOCH raced midpack, closed into the turn, forced the issue four-wide, chased into the stretch then evened out. NORTHOFFIFTY raced midpack, angled four to six-wide through the then, was hustled into the stretch, finished gamely but did not threaten. ALERO EXPRESS vied early, gained command entering the turn, set a pressured pace, was engaged at the top of the stretch, dueled, was passed

midstretch and weakened. TRAJECTORY'S DREAM raced off the pace from the outside, angled five to seven-wide late turn while closing then evened out in the stretch. JAZ RYDER, in touch early between horses, was hustled on the turn then evened out in the stretch. LURCHUS ORILIOS raced off the pace, raced four then five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but showed no late response. CONISTON raced midpack, came four-wide through the turn, was roused but had no late response. TRAJECTORY LINE stumbled at the start, settled well off the pace, angled out from the second path to five-wide through the turn and failed to menace. HOWIEDOIN raced off the pace between foes, was three and four-wide on the turn and lacked a rally. NEW SURROUNDINGS raced off the pace from the inside, was hustled on the turn then tired in the stretch. FAGAN was unhurried early, trailed throughout and lacked a rally.
