ESSENCE HIT MAN gained a short lead on the backstretch, set a pressured pace while still in hand, shook clear at the top of the stretch then was asked for more, was under serious pressure from ETERNAL RULE in the final furlong and answered courageously, holding him safe to the wire. ETERNAL RULE showed brief speed then settled and stalked the pace three-wide, launched his rally and lapped on to the leader in the final furlong, was determined but could not get by. BERGERAC raced off the pace, was hustled along the second path on the turn, chased hard into the stretch and finished determinedly, closing steadily along the rail. LONESOME STREET in range, chased hard on the turn and was all out through the stretch. EXECUTIVE FIVE showed speed then forced the issue, chased the pacesetter into the stretch and tired.
