SHERATON PARK dueled briefly, drew clear midway of the backstretch, set a reserved pace and held sway under a hand ride. ALACHUA, in range and in hand early, chased three-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly. STORMY ILLUSION, in touch, chased four-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. POLITELYPRECOCIOUS raced midpack, angled from the rail to three-wide on the turn, launched an all out drive in the stretch but did not threaten. THE CAT'S AFFAIR had brief speed, stalked the pace, was hustled late turn but showed no late response. CLASSY GEM raced off the pace, saved ground but lacked a rally. DELI LAMA raced midpack, was hustled four-wide into the stretch but never reached contention. WINNING DOE stalked from the rail, was roused upper stretch but had no response. STREET GOSSIP, well back early, angled from the second to the sixth turn then lacked a closing response. ASTROTIME raced off the pace, angled three to five-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. RED RIVER JANE raced off the pace, came two and three-wide

through the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out. CAMPFIRE GIRL broke through the starting gate and trailed the field under a gallop. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START DEEMED THAT CAMPFIRE GIRL HAD RECEIVED AN UNFAIR START NECESSITATING A REFUND.
