Footnotes

FATAL BULLET stalked the pace, bid late turn, drove clear upper stretch and was kept to task through the final furlong. DISFUNCTION raced forwardly from the outset, set a pressured pace and shook clear briefly early turn, was engaged late turn, dueled into the stretch then was no match for the winner. LAST GRAN STANDING was well back along the rail in the early stages, closed two-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. LEGAL MOVE raced off the early pace, closed three-wide on the turn then evened out late. PAPA BEAR, well back early, closed four then three-wide on the turn, was all out in the stretch but never reached contention. GANGSTER trailed along the rail, angled four-wide while closing late turn but came up empty in the stretch. HE'S SO CHIC was used early and forced the pace, gave way early turn and chased to the stretch then tired.
