HIGHLAND HOLIDAY forced the pace briefly then was taken back, stayed in range, chased five-wide late turn, rallied and got by late under a hand ride. BAILEY'S RING, rated off the pace, was hustled from early turn, chased five-wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. JOVIAL JILL led midway of the backstretch, was headed briefly then drove to the lead into the turn, was roused late turn but was caught upper stretch, dueled to the late stages but was passed. SKY HALO closed along the rail nearing the turn, was headed, pressed the pace, rebid upper stretch, dueled, was passed late and tired. EXECUTIVELY, prominent early, forced the pace, was squeezed back early turn, chased to the late stages and evened out. BELIEVE THE FOX steadied just out, closed on the backstretch, chased on the turn, was hustled into the stretch and tired. SPEED DATING raced midpack, closed late backstretch, was taken back at the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. CLEARLY IN CHARGE raced off the pace, closed late backstretch then chased on the turn, was hustled into the stretch but tired.
