STRATEGIC HOPE stalked the pace, closed upper stretch, took command in the final furlong and finished under a drive. UNCLE CARM raced in midpack, chased late turn and finished gamely in vain. SIMPLY SMART raced in midpack, was hustled late turn then rallied willingly, but late. FRIDAY NIGHT GUY stalked the duel, chased hard late turn and was all out through the stretch. OUTOFTHEDEPTHS, in touch, chased five-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. SPECIAL SELECTION dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased, then evened out midstretch. SARDONICUS, off slowly, raced off the

pace, chased five-wide late turn then rallied belatedly outside. HOME AT SIX dueled, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was caught in the final furlong, chased briefly and tired. TIME FOR THE STARS settled off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. SPUR TREE raced in midpack, dropped back late turn and was game but lacked a serious rally. JULIANSHOME raced off the pace, chased late turn then lacked a closing response. MATTER OF TRUTH, in touch along the rail, chased late turn then flattened out midstretch. BELL'S FIRST LAD raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch.
