**Footnotes**

ONE WORD dueled, shook clear on the turn then widened under an all out drive through the stretch. BEST IN EGBERT raced in midpack, closed along the rail late turn, finished gamely and was best of the rest. SLEWMOBIL dueled, chased on the turn then evened out midstretch. I'M NO FAIRYTAIL stumbled at the start, raced off the pace, closed along the rail late turn and finished gamely in vain. TOBERMORY was hustled from midpack, chased hard late turn then flattened out in the late stages. LEVEL ROAD chased three-wide in striking range but lacked a stretch response. REIGNERS LANE raced off the pace, chased hard on the turn but never reached contention. RIVER CARD raced off the pace, chased late turn but failed to menace. BANKER LARRY raced in midpack, was hustled between foes on the turn, was roused but showed no response. CANDLES ON FRIDAY, off slowly, was always well back. GREEN FORESTER raced in midpack, chased on the turn then tired in the stretch.
