GRAND CUVEE moved up quickly to engage the early leader, dueled, shook clear late turn, widened when asked and finished under a hand ride. DABBLEMUP settled off the pace, was hustled angling from the rail to three-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. GRABTHEMONEYANDRUN showed brief speed then settled in midpack, closed into the turn, chased, but evened out in the late stages. MCQUEEN LAKE raced in midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn, was steadied when lugging in a bit at the top of the stretch, straightened away but was not a threat. MR. ZIPPY settled well back early, saved ground while chasing on the turn, was hustled into the stretch but never reached contention. DROP TO POP stalked the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. REFUGEE STATUS led quickly but was joined in a duel early backstretch, yielded late turn, chased into the stretch and tired a furlong out.
