MISS NOIRE stalked the early pace outside of rivals, drew even at the quarter pole, assumed command in upper stretch and drew clear under steady pressure. MULRAINY was hustled along between horses pressing the early pace, could not stay with the leaders on the turn, but rallied in the drive and got up for place. FORUM SEARCH led between calls in the backstretch, then dropped back on the turn and edged off the rail, made a mild bid in upper stretch, but weakened in the late going. STYLELISTICK was slow early just off the rail, swung wide entering the stretch and closed willingly outside of rivals. FAR AND NEAR was void of early speed between horses, then finished with a mild rally along the rail. WHISTLING MAID sprinted to the early lead, then tired in the late going and dropped back. PYRITE MENU was allowed to settle four wide and lacked a late response. WILD ANZILLE was void of early speed three wide and never rallied. SMART CHOICE was hustled along between horses, then dropped back on the turn. FIGHTING SHOT was hustled along inside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn.
