Footnotes

EVER AFTER was void of early speed, angled outside of the leaders midway through the turn and rallied four wide, opened a clear lead in the final furlong under left handed urging, bore out in the late going and was under mild urging at the wire just holding off BYZANTINE. The latter was slow early just off the rail, swung wide in upper stretch and followed the winner, angled outside of that one in the final furlong, but was steadied in the late going when EVER AFTER came out and impeded his run, got back on track in the final strides and closed the gap at the wire. EXCEPT FOR WANDA stalked the early pace inside of rivals, angled out in upper stretch and loomed boldly, but failed to respond and dropped back in the drive. SERENA'S TUNE was well rated on a clear lead in the early going, but faltered in mid stretch and dropped back. PRADO STAR was allowed to settle in the three path, closed the gap on the turn, but lacked a late response. LA BELLE BLEU was allowed to settle in the two path and never rallied. BRANKSOME HALL was unhurried early inside of rivals, never rallied and dropped back in the drive.
