CALL ME LOU, away alertly, was headed, settled and stalked the pace, angled out late turn, swept by a furlong out and finished under a hand ride. VIGILARE raced off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn then rallied gamely. MAIL ORDER GROOM settled off the early pace, was hustled three-wide late turn then finished determinedly between foes. REIMER forced the issue, bid midturn, dueled, wore down his rivals upper stretch but was passed a furlong out and tired. HARD TO FIND forced the pace, bid midturn, dueled three-wide then gave way upper stretch. COLT DU JOUR, off slowly, was sent to the lead, set a pressured pace, was joined midturn, dueled, then tired a furlong out. B VEXED, off a step slowly, settled off the pace, saved ground but lacked a rally.
