ALLENDE was allowed to settle inside of rivals in the early going, edged off the rail and raced three wide into the far turn, dueled between horses in the drive and drew clear under steady urging. MUNTEJ (GB) was well rated just off the rail in the first half of the race, waited patiently on the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch and dueled to the wire, could not stay with the winner in the final strides, but prevailed for second. QUIET RESOLVE was unhurried early outside of CERTAINLY CLASSIC, closed the gap along the rail on the turn, came outside of KIMBERLITE PIPE in upper stretch and dueled to the wire, but weakened in the final strides. KIMBERLITE PIPE set the early pace in hand and unchallenged, held the advantage in upper stretch, but faltered in mid stretch and dropped back. THREE WONDERS was allowed to settle outside of rivals, roused three wide on the turn, but was never a threat. CERTAINLY CLASSIC was well rated between horses, but failed to respond and dropped back in the stretch. RIVER BOAT was in hand inside of rivals, then dropped back and moved off the rail in the drive, but failed to respond and was never a threat.
