Footnotes

GALAXY, unhurried early, closed along the rail on the far turn, angled out between foes at the top of the stretch, rallied smartly and got up late. DYTRYIN stalked the pace, closed along the rail on the far turn, took command at the top of the stretch, drew off, then failed to hold in the late stages. GIVE ME AN INCH dueled inside on the third path, was headed at the top of the stretch and evened out. SALVO raced off the pace from the third and fourth paths, angled to the rail at the top of the stretch but evened out late. ONE WAY CONNECTION dueled, chased on the fourth-path on the far turn then tired at the top of the stretch. RUN ON stalked from the fifth path, lacked a rally. DAKOTA FREEWAY, off a step slowly, remained in touch early then faded on the far turn. CRAFTY DANIEL stalked, bid three-wide midway of the backstretch, vied on the fifth path then tired late turn.
