GOLDEN GLADE forced the pace, took command nearing the turn, set a pressured pace then drove clear upper stretch and held sway under steady handling. CAPTAIN MARK stalked the early pace then settled midpack, was hustled through the turn and rallied determinedly. PIT ALLEY, well back early, remained unhurried to the stretch then rallied inside. ON WINGS OF TRUST stalked the pace, was hustled on the turn, chased along the rail into the stretch, was all out then evened out in the late stages. EASTERMAN, rated early, closed late turn, came seven-wide to the top of the stretch and finished gamely. READ THE STARS raced off the pace between horses, was hustled into the stretch then rallied gamely. CAMBRIDGE BLUE broke outward, raced well back, closed late turn, came eight-wide to the top of the stretch and rallied in vain. NIGHT CHAPEL raced midpack, chased between foes late turn, was blocked briefly midstretch and evened out. NO MORE LAKES, well back early, was hustled along the rail late turn, chased into the stretch and flattened out midstretch. SINCERELY A TO Z forced the pace early, chased into the turn, was hustled along but tired in the final furlong. PRATTLE raced off the pace, saved ground but lacked a response in the final furlong. MAJESTIC TRIBUTE settled midpack, chased five-wide into the stretch then flattened out. A P VALOR, always well back, was hustled eight-wide into the stretch then lacked a rally. CHEERS MATE led early, set a pressured pace, was headed nearing the turn, chased hard to the stretch and tired.
