CAPTAIN CROW raced forwardly, dueled on the turn, drove clear in the final furlong and held PARK PLACE safe under light handling. PARK PLACE stalked the pace from the rail, angled out upper stretch, rallied late and missed. SMART EXECUTIVE moved up to duel into the turn, was game to the final furlong then gave way grudgingly. CORBELLI, in touch early, settled off the pace early turn, closed into the stretch and finished willingly. BOW BELL REEF raced midpack between rivals, angled three to six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but failed to menace. BOLD PHIL raced midpack four-wide, was roused late turn then finished evenly. JINX BUSTER raced off the pace, was hustled angling out from five to eight-wide late turn and finished all out. OH BOY broke outward, straightened away quickly and pressed the pace to the turn, settled back a bit and stalked to the stretch, chased briefly in the stretch and tired. RIDGEWAY raced off the pace, came three to five-wide through the turn and did not threaten. WINDANCER'SBOLDONE raced in midpack, chased four to seven-wide on the turn then lacked a stretch response. KNIGHT OF ASCOT broke in the air, trailed along the rail then lacked a rally.
