QUICK CODE broke outward, raced off the pace, closed five-wide late turn, swept by the leader in the final furlong and widened under a hand ride. THOR'S PIPER raced in midpack, chased hard late turn and finished determinedly to the wire. MAJOR BRAVO, away alertly, stalked the pace, chased five-wide late turn and finished all out. ZIP IT NANCE set a reserved pace, quickened late turn, was passed nearing midstretch and gave way. THORNWOOD ROAD, rated off the pace, was hustled from the rail to six-wide on the turn then tendered a mild late rally between foes. HOLY POPPI raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. FINDING THE TIME raced in midpack, saved ground while being patiently ridden and lacked a rally. EVERYONE raced in the middle of the pack, was hustled on the turn but backed away and tired.
