Footnotes

SHOAL WATER stalked the pace from the second path, edged up outside MOBIL midway through the far turn, engaged that one in earnest at the top of the stretch, took a short lead then held him safe under steady pressure. MOBIL set a reserved pace from the rail, was engaged at the top of the stretch, was well-headed with a furlong to run but finished very gamely. STRUT THE STAGE in hand early along the rail, angled out at the top of the stretch and rallied willingly. CONTROL TOWER stalked from the rail and was always in striking range then launched an all-out drive in the stretch but hung. PERFECT SOUL (IRE) raced midpack and was four-wide early, gained slightly three-deep on the far turn but hung in the stretch. SLEW VALLEY stalked the pace from the fourth path then evened out in the stretch. BOWMAN MILL was well back early and under strong restraint, raced along the second path and lacked a response when asked. CETEWAYO moved to the rail shortly after leaving the gate, saved ground to the backstretch then moved four-wide and trailed to the finish.
