Footnotes

ALTIUS led early, set a reserved pace then held GANGSTER RAP safe under steady pressure. GANGSTER RAP forced the early pace, dropped back nearing the turn, was hustled along then rallied inside and was gaining steadily. HIPPOLYTUS forced the issue, chased on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. EXECUTIVE FIVE, close early, was hustled on the turn but lacked a rally. MOMENTSTHATMATTER raced well back, angled five-wide closing late turn, tendered a mild rally but did not threaten. NEAR EXPECTATIONS raced off the pace, was hustled into the stretch but never reached contention. THE BULL GOT SHOT, close early, chased into the turn, raced five-wide to the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. GRAN TSAR broke poorly, raced well back then passed tiring horses. MO STAR raced off the pace, saved ground, was hustled late turn but tired in the stretch. MAN O' METTLE settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch.
