DOCTOR JACK chased in range from between horses, angled six-wide late turn, responded smartly and surged to the lead just into the final furlong and widened sharply under a drive. AREPEATTEE closed late backstretch, bid into the turn, dueled five and six-wide, was headed at the top of the stretch but finished gamely. OLD BUD bid into the turn, dueled four and five-wide, was headed at the top of the stretch but finished gamely in vain. RUBEN SQUIRES, in range, closed along the rail then two-wide on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch and quickly drove clear, was passed in the final furlong and chased to the end. IT'S TIME BEAR was hustled to the early lead, was engaged at the turn, dueled but was headed while four-wide at the top of the stretch and chased to the end. FLIM FLAM was hustled from off the pace, angled three to five-wide on the turn, was roused in the stretch but had no late response. ACCOMPLICE, off a step slowly, was rated on the backstretch then hustled on the turn angling from four-wide to the eighth path but never reached contention. BOLT WEST, off a step slowly, was hustled along the rail on the turn then evened out in the stretch. HOOD POINT forced the pace to the turn, chased hard to the stretch and bled. LOVIN WAY, up close early, dropped back at the turn, was hustled three to six-wide then tired in the stretch.
