PERFECT SOUL (IRE) was well rated in the three path just off the early lead, closed the gap on the turn and assumed command in upper stretch with no urging, opened a clear lead in mid stretch and was under mild urging in the final sixteenth. MELLOWES set the early pace in hand and unchallenged, gave way to the winner in upper stretch, but finished well and held place. NORTHERNPROSPECTOR was unhurried early three wide, angled out in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. MERLIN'S MOON was allowed to settle along the rail, closed the gap entering the stretch, but flattened out in the final furlong. RIVER BOAT was unhurried early in the three path, roused in upper stretch and made a mild bid, but was never a threat. FOLLOW THE PIPER was well rated between horses, but failed to respond and dropped back in the drive. REASONABLE RUMOR was void of early speed three wide, roused in upper stretch, but never rallied and was never a factor. TEPU SULTAN was void of early speed and outrun.
