HOLY SCHNEIKIES unhurried in the early going, kept in touch, then bid into the stretch from the four path, caught the leaders and finished with good energy. PORT STANLEY never far back and outside of foes on the far turn, bid outside to loom a danger only to be outkicked by the winner. COOL GATOR tracked from between foes, kept in the hunt then angled out in the late going and finished with a mild bid. SEPTEMBER SQUARE dueled for the lead from outside of rival, led on the far turn and was clear into the stretch then gave way in the drive. BIG FOOT PAPA dueled inside, was a factor into the far turn then tired from the rail. MEDIDOCIHOSPISURG stalked inside of foes and was in the game into the far turn then lacked a stretch finish. MIGHTY MONARCH had an off the pace outside trip and did not menace.
